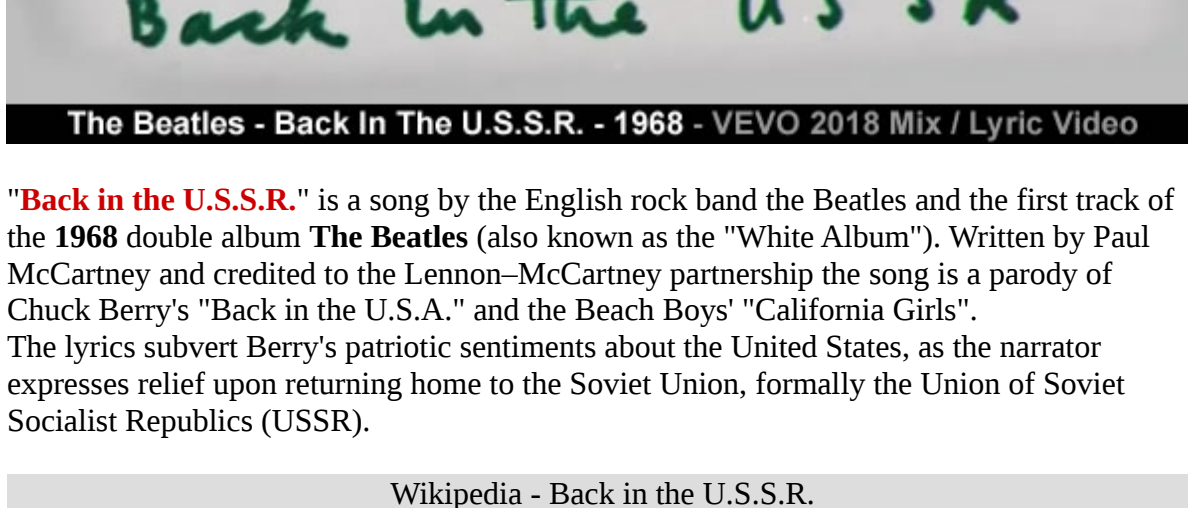

The jeans brand Rokotov and Fainberg is named after the defendants in the Rokotov–Faibishenko case, Yan T. Rokotov and Vladislav P. Faibishenko, who were executed for, among other things, trafficking in jeans.

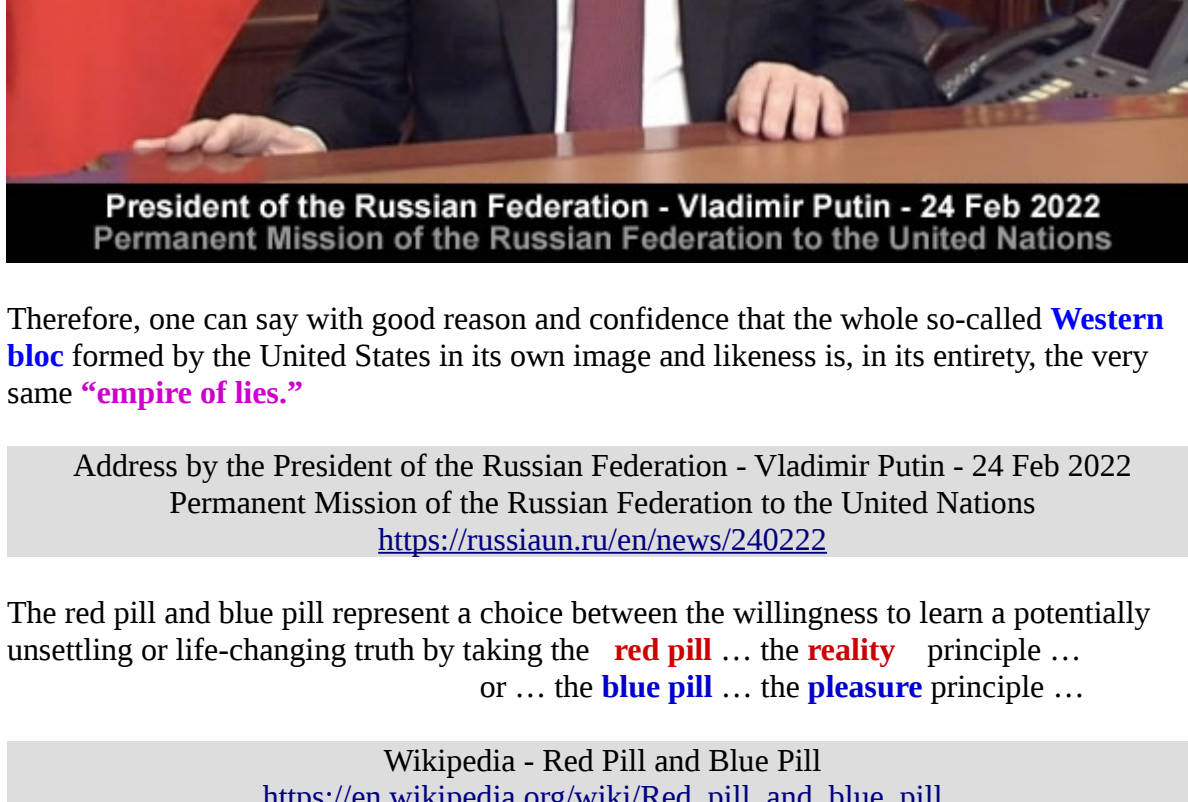
Although not outright banned, jeans were hard to come by in the Soviet Union since they were seen as a symbol of rebellion by **the Soviet youth**, who **wanted to emulate the style of film and rock stars of the West**. The Soviet government resisted supplying the market with jeans as it would mean responding to the market, a capitalist principle.

People went to great lengths, sometimes by resorting to violence and other illegal activities, to obtain real Western-made jeans. That led to the creation of black markets and to the bootlegging of jeans, which since has become an important cultural element of the history of the Soviet Union.

The Second Red Scare, which occurred **immediately after World War II**, was preoccupied with the perception that national or foreign communists were infiltrating or subverting American society and the federal government.

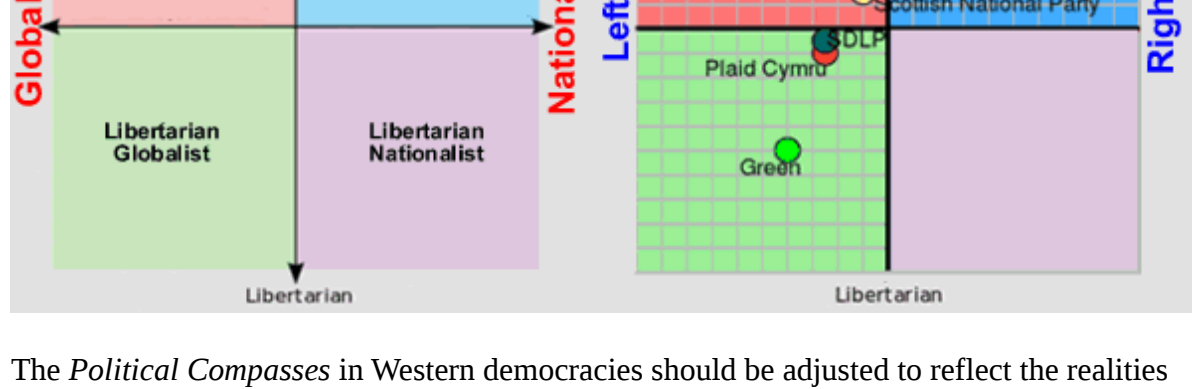

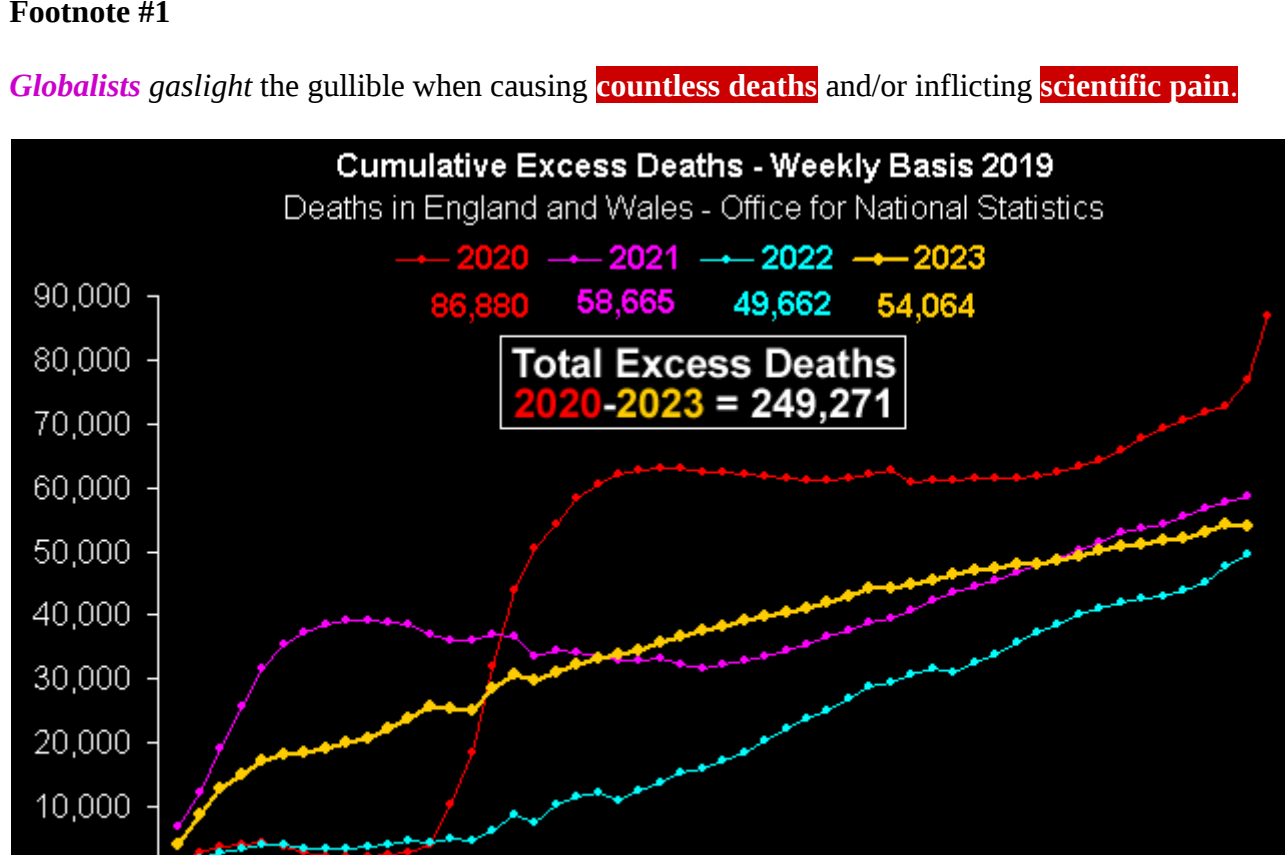

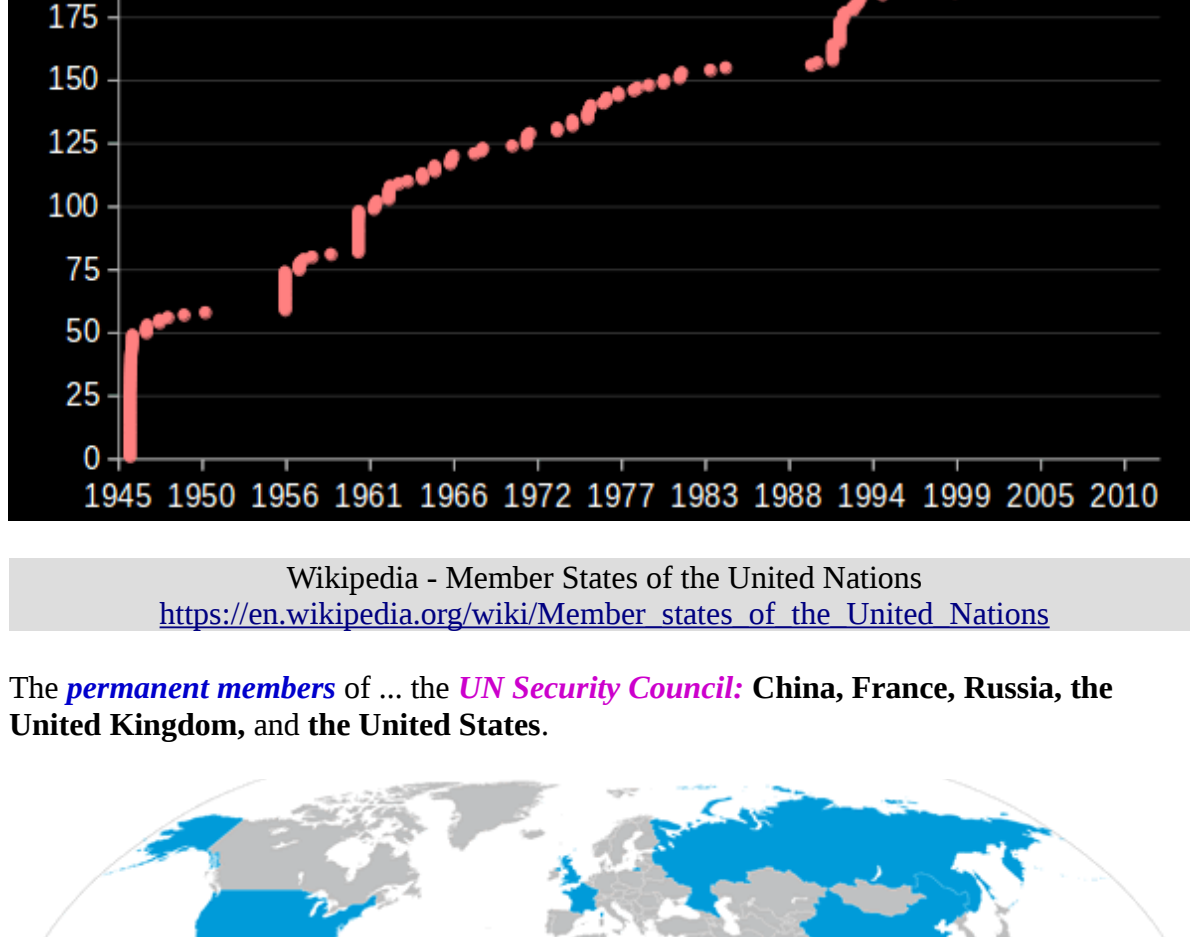

The **permanent members** of ... the **UN Security Council**: **China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States**.



The **permanent members** were all **Allies in World War II** (and the victors of that war), and are the five states with the first and most nuclear weapons.

All have the power of veto which enables any one of them to prevent the adoption of any "substantive" draft Council resolution, regardless of its level of international support.

The remaining 10 members of the **UN Security Council** are elected by the **General Assembly**, giving a total of 15 **UN member states** on the **Security Council**.

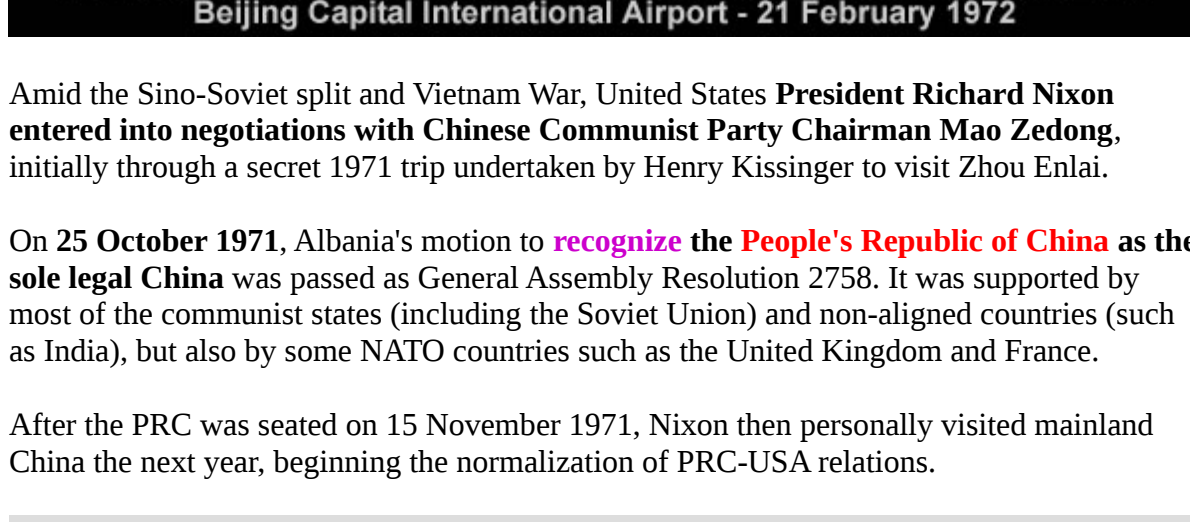

... the **Republic of China** (ROC) joined the **UN** upon its founding in 1945.

The subsequent resumption of the Chinese Civil War between the government of Republic of China and the rebel forces of the Chinese Communist Party, led to the latter's victory on the mainland and the **establishment of the People's Republic of China** (PRC) in 1949.

Nearly all of Mainland China was soon under its control and the ROC government retreated to the island of Taiwan.

The One-China policy advocated by both governments dismantled the solution of dual representation but, amid the Cold War and Korean War, the **United States** and its allies **opposed the replacement of the ROC at the United Nations until 1971** ...



Amid the Sino-Soviet split and Vietnam War, United States **President Richard Nixon entered into negotiations with Chinese Communist Party Chairman Mao Zedong**, initially through a secret 1971 trip undertaken by Henry Kissinger to visit Zhou Enlai.

On **25 October 1971**, Albania's motion to **recognize the People's Republic of China as the sole legal China** was passed as General Assembly Resolution 2758. It was supported by most of the communist states (including the Soviet Union) and non-aligned countries (such as India), but also by some NATO countries such as the United Kingdom and France.

After the PRC was seated on 15 November 1971, Nixon then personally visited mainland China the next year, beginning the normalization of PRC-USA relations.

How many Member States are there?

There are currently **193** Member States of the United Nations. The latest State to join the United Nations was South Sudan (in 2011). According to Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations:

- "1. Membership in the United Nations is open to all ... peace-loving states which accept the obligations contained in the present Charter and, in the judgment of the Organization, are able and willing to carry out these obligations.
- "2. The admission of any such state to membership in the United Nations will be effected by a decision of the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Security Council."

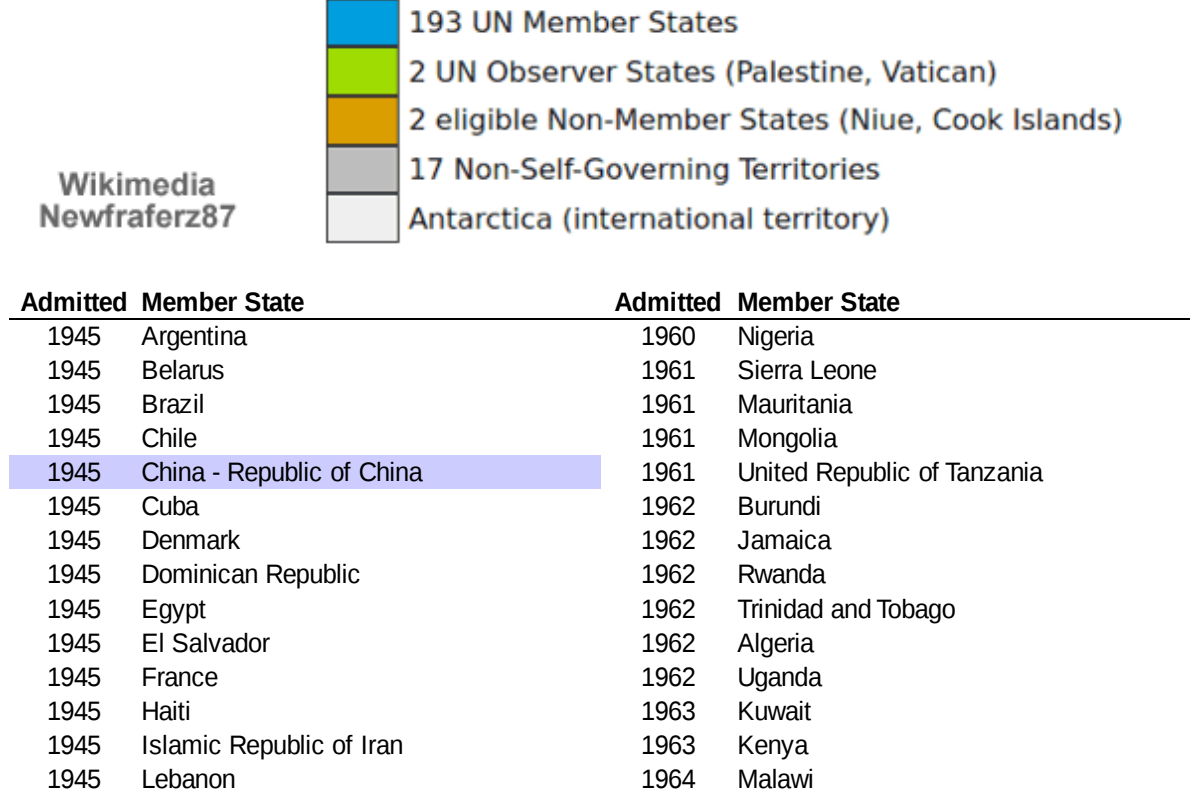
Can a Member State be expelled from the United Nations?

Article 6 of the Charter reads as follows:

"**A Member** of the United Nations which has persistently violated the Principles contained in the present Charter **may be expelled** from the Organization by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Security Council."

This has never happened.

Contrarily, in the West the majority suffers through the slings and arrows of a veritable new Spanish Inquisition for the sake of some imaginary victimized minority.

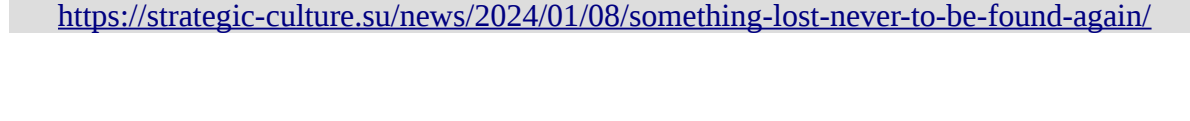
In reality, this minority has been induced and weaponized as a mere institutional guignol against those who pose the greatest threat to the social-engineers of authority.

A sense of something lost and never to be found again, which we all endure these days.

The 'Elect' though, have deliberately raised the stakes.

They do not want to 'let go'.

They have determined that, with the western train wrecked on its own cultural 'wall', the 'End of Time' of convergence on a common future is 'over' too.

And along with it, the claimed western mandate to dictate the 'direction forward' is over also.
